MOBILE DEVICES of the seven accused in the Elgaar Parishad case will be submitted to the Supreme Court-appointed committee which is looking into allegations of unauthorised surveillance using Pegasus spyware, after the seven requested the committee to call for their devices for inspection.

The court said that the articles mentioned in the NIA plea -- 25

of the court to open the seal on the articles in presence of the accused and their lawyers on Wednesday. The articles will then be resealed and handed over to the investigation officer to submit them to the SC panel. The three-member committee has sought for the devices to be submitted on February 10. After the committee makes digital copies of the devices, they will be returned to the court as they are part of the evidence against the accused for the trial.

Applications to the committee for submission of their devices were sent by Rona Wilson, Sudha Bharadwaj, Vernon Gonsalves, Hany Babu, Shoma Sen, Anand Teltumbde and P Varavara Rao. stating that they suspect their devices were infected by Pegasus spyware. The committee had written to the NIA, seeking the devices, after the pleas of the seven said that they want to submit their devices but are not in a position to do so since they are with the court.

The mobile phones of the ac-

cused were seized at the time of their arrests by Pune City Police, which initially probed the case, and then the NIA, which took over the probe in 2020.

The Supreme Court-appointed committee had last month issued a public notice calling upon people who had 'reasonable cause' to suspect that their mobile instrument had been infected/compromised due to specific usage of Pegasus, a spyware developed by Israeli firm NSO Group, to come before the committee with reasons as to why they believe their devices may have been infected.

The accused, in their representation before the committee, separately stated the reasons behind their suspicion of their devices being infected with the spyware. Wilson has approached the Bombay High Court with a writ petition filed last year referring to a report by a US-based independent forensic firm Arsenal Consulting, which said that his computer was 'infected with a malware' planted two years before his arrest in 2018.

the SEC. The state government has conveyed to the SEC that it has fulfilled the order of the apex court and urged the SEC to take further appropriate action on providing reservation to OBCs. We feel that SEC should give OBC reservations in the upcoming local body elections," said Chhagan

Bhubal, senior NCP minister. Bhujbal said the MSCBC in the interim report has endorsed that "the percentage of OBC in Maharashtra may be much more than 38 per cent". "With this, the 27 per cent reservation can be given to OBCs," he added.

Sources from the SEC said it has received the letter along with the MSCBC's interim report. "The SEC then held a meeting with the Chief Secretary and officials from the Urban Development and Rural Development Department to discuss the further course of action," said an official requesting anonymity.

Another official said the SEC has asked the government to get an order on the interim report from the Supreme Court. "If the Supreme Court gives an order, then we can immediately restore the OBC quota in local bodies, added the official.

Sources from the government said the hearing on the OBC quota in the apex court could not take place on Tuesday as the matter didn't come on board. "We hope that the matter will come on board tomorrow and Supreme Court will hear the matter," said an official.

In January, the Supreme Court had asked the government to submit data on OBCs to the MSCBC to examine its correctness and make recommendations on their representation in elections for the local bodies. The government then handed over the data to the MSCBC and requested it to submit an interim report at the earliest.

If the meter is working properly then it will be re-installed by the BMC at its current cost. But if the meter is found to be faulty or tampered with, then the owner will have to get it repaired within one month and get it tested by paying the testing charges. After testing, if the meter is working properly, then the owner must pay charges and then the BMC will connect it to the waterline.

The official said that the upgraded meters have a little chance of tampering. The proposed policy, the civic body hopes, will also boost the revenue of the water department.

In addition, the civic body has outsourced the process of procurement to a few empanelled manufacturers, from whom customers can purchase water meters directly.

Govt to launch awareness drive to seek classical language status for Marathi

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE MUMBAI, FEBRUARY 8

THE CENTRE should accord Marathi the status of a classical language, senior minister Subash Desai demanded on Tuesday.

A state-wide awareness campaign will be launched to reassert the state government's demand, said Desai. The decision to take up the issue comes ahead of the Marathi Bhasha Gaurav Diwas on February 27.

"We will launch an awareness campaign across the state through various forums to press for our demand for classical language status to Marathi," said Desai. The awareness programme will be held through various mediums such as TV, newspapers, news channels,

radio, social media and short films. In 2004, the government of India undertook an initiative to grant classical language status to languages. Till date, six languages -- Tamil, Sanskrit, Malayalam, Telugu, Kannada and Odia -- have been given classical language sta-

tus. The central government has

laid down certain criteria for ob-

taining this status. To ascertain if Marathi fulfills the eligibility criteria, the Ranganath Pathare Committee was constituted. The Committee has, in an affidavit prepared by linguists, unanimously recommended that Marathi should be given classical status. It has now been seven years since the report was presented by the committee
