Teen swept away in flash flood near Coimbatore

Heavy rain batters Kovai and Nilgiris | Noyyal river overflows; landslips in various places

HEAVY downpour was reported across Coimbatore and Nilgiris districts from Wednesday night. Mettupalayam recorded the highest rainfall of 37.3 cm and Noyyal river overflowed. Holiday was declared for schools in Karamadai block in Coimbatore and in Nilgiris on Thursday.

Three youths were caught in a flash flood at Elerumapallam near Kottaiyiruvu in Mathampalayam on Wednesday night. The incident took place when they tried to cross a bridge in a two-wheeler while returning to Kotagiri after attending a friend's wedding in Karamadai.

While two youths escaped to safety, J Pradeep Raj, 19, of Katabettu was washed away. As many as 18 Fire and Rescue Service personnel are searching for the youth. "Despite searching for 5 km, Fire and Rescue Service personnel were unable to trace him. Along with staff from Periyanaickenpalayam fire service office, more personnel from Thudiyalur also engaged in the search," said M Karthikesan Fire officer of Periyanaickenpalayam fire station.

Traffic was suspended between Mettupalayam and Kotagiri from 6am to 3pm after landslides occurred at 15 places.

According to Mettupalayam fire officer K Balasundaram a major landslide occurred at Kunjappanad and a tree fell on the road around 5am on Thursday. Landslips were reported in four other places and a few trees fell on the Mettupalayam-Coonoor road. Fire and rescue service personnel cleared them along with state highway workers.

Cases against news portal editor dropped

ERNAKULAM Central police have dropped two cases registered against Shajan Skariah, the editor of Marunadan Malayali news portal, for publishing a misleading video on Kalamassery bomb blasts.

The cases were dropped after Thiruvananthapuram City cyber police and Kumarakom police registered cases against Shajan in connection with the same incident. Recently, Shajan approached the Ernakulam District and Principal Sessions Court seeking anticipatory bail in both cases. However, the pleas were closed after the police informed the court that cases against Shajan registered at Ernakulam Central police station were dropped. The case was registered after the video posted on YouTube by the portal claimed that the blasts at Kalamassery were a retaliation against Israel's attack on Palestine.

Peruvanam's pride Kuttan Marar to turn 70 tomorrow

'LEGENDS are born, not made' is a popular saying, which one can relate to chenda maestro Peruvanam Kuttan Marar, the one who led many a 'Melam' for years. His humility can be understood when people around him call the legend 'Kuttettan'. From one temple premise to another, Kuttettan travelled all over Kerala leading percussion ensembles and entertaining the public with his extraordinary skills.

As Peruvanam's 'Kuttettan' celebrates his 70th birthday on Saturday, the entire village is ready to make it a grand occasion. Leading the world's largest percussion ensemble 'Elanjithara Melam' for Paramakkavu Bhagavathi in Thirissur Pooram for a consecutive 24 years is something rare and it proclaims the kind of genius that he is.

For Peruvanam Kuttan Marar aka M Sankaranarayanan, learning the art of percussion

was a part of his lineage. Born to percussion maestro Peruvanam Appu Marar, learning and then drumming came organically and he never thought it something different. "It was part of my life and always an inevitable one. The days just went by as I continued the practice like my father and forefathers did. Later when I took the 'Pranam' of Elanjithara Melam, it started getting attention and became more popular. Thus opened a wide stage, perhaps a new world to showcase the beauty of the wonderful orchestra that we have inherited traditionally. I am happy so far and want to take this journey as long as health permits," said Kuttan Marar, sitting in the 'Nadavazhi' of Peruvanam Mahadeva temple, where it all began.

In his career spanning five

decades, Kuttan Marar has led the 'Pranam' of Panchari and Pandi Melam in many prominent temples like Tripunithura Poornathrayeesa temple, Arattupuzha Saastha temple, Irinjaalkkuda

Koodalmanickayam temple, Kuttanellur Bhagavathy temple and also in Guruvayur Sree Krishna temple.

When asked about his favourite 'Melam', 'Kuttettan' smiles and says: "Without doubt, it is Peruvanam pooram, because everything began from there. However, all the recognition and love that I enjoy today is actually because of Elanjithara Melam."

Wishing him all goodness and happiness in life, Mattannur Sankaranikutty, chairman of Kerala Sangeetha Nataka Akademi, and a renowned percussion artist himself, shared that Peruvanam Kuttan Marar was born to a family of eminent percussion artists in a village where the artform thrived for years. "This makes him the greatest in the field," he said. Also, Mattannur didn't hesitate to share his discontent on what Paramakkavu Devaswom showed to a maestro, indicating the change of Pranam in Elanjithara Melam in the last

Thirissur Pooram.

For festival fans across Kerala, 'Kuttettan' is someone who handles a percussion ensemble well, be it timing or the number of artists. "Only an experienced person can do it. Anyone who wants to survive in this field, not only has to learn the art form, but needs to perform in all possible venues with the most talented leaders in the field. It helps one gain knowledge about handling the crew well," says Kuttan Marar, about his secret to the well-handled performances in the festivals.

Recognizing the immense contribution made by Kuttan Marar to Peruvanam and to the field of 'Vadyakala', the well-wishers will organise 'Vasanthasapthathi' on Friday and Saturday at Mahatma Maidanam in Cherpu. Noted personalities like Drummer Sivamani and Oscar winner Resool Pookutty will attend the event, extending their love and warmth to 'Kuttettan' - the 'Pride of Peruvanam'.

Mariyakutty files defamation case against daily for spreading false news

IDUKKI native Mariyakutty, who was in the news recently for seeking alms from the public after her social welfare pension got delayed for the past five months, filed a defamation suit against CPM mouthpiece for carrying a false report against her. Though the paper had carried a corrigendum on the news report, Mariyakutty was not ready to accept it. She said that the correction wasn't enough to cover the mental agony she had to undergo. She filed the suit on Thursday at the First Class Magistrate Court in Adimaly.



Mariyakutty's lawyer Prathesh Prabha told mediapersons that she filed a petition against

10 persons, including the chief editor of the newspaper. "The first four accused in the case are those associated with the newspaper which published the fake news while the remaining ones are those who spread the false news on social media handles," Prathesh said.

After the news came out, Mariyakutty filed an application seeking details of her land ownership, if any, with the revenue authorities in it. On November 13, the Mannankandam village officer certified that Mariyakutty owned no properties within his jurisdictional area.

Mariyakutty told TNIE that despite fabricating fake media reports, the CPM has not so far made any attempt to find a so-

lution to her issue or tried to understand her situation.

"I have four daughters, the eldest one Sali works as a gospel preacher in Delhi and my second daughter is married and settled in Wayanad. My third daughter is settled in Ayiramekkar nearby and my youngest daughter Princy is selling lottery tickets in Adimaly," she said.

"After my husband eloped with another woman 25 years ago, I managed to marry off my daughters doing odd jobs. However, after I underwent cataract surgery, going to work has become difficult," she said.

Mariyakutty said she had been making ends meet with the 4kg of rice she gets as monthly ration and with the support of local people who often give her food and money.

Sreesanth booked in cheating case

Kozhikode: Kannur Town police have registered a cheating case against former India cricketer S Sreesanth and two others, Rajeev Kumar and Venkatesh Kini, on charges of extorting ₹18 lakh from Kannur resident Sareekh Balagopal. The case was registered following the order of the Kannur First Class Magistrate Court. As per the complainant, the accused took ₹18,70,000 from Sareekh promising a villa on a 5-cent land in Udipi, Karnataka. Rajeev and Venkatesh took money in several instalments from Sareekh from 2019. However, he didn't get any further updates from the duo. Later, he was informed that Sreesanth was starting a sports academy on the land promised to Sareekh. Sreesanth promised Sareekh that a share of his sports academy would be given to him, but Sareekh never heard anything on the offer from the trio thereafter.
